Rate the Quality of Life (Question #2)

- As a place to live 58% said good or excellent
- Your neighborhood as a place to live 71% said good or excellent
- As a place to raise children 56% said good or excellent
- As a place to work 72% said good or excellent
- As a place to visit 33% said good or excellent
- As a place to retire 37% said good or excellent
- The overall quality of life in Hanford 56% said good or excellent
- Sense of community 44% said good or excellent



Rate the Quality of City Services (Question #10)

Police Department

- Police/Sheriff services

- Excellent/Good=61%
- Fair/Poor=40%

- Crime Prevention

- Excellent/Good=35%
- Fair/Poor=65%



Rate the Quality of City Services (Question #10)

Fire Department

- Fire Services
 - Excellent/Good=76%
 - Fair/Poor=24%
- Emergency preparedness (services that prepare the community for natural disasters or other emergency situations)
 - Excellent/Good=44%
 - Fair/Poor=56%



Rate the Quality of City Services (Question # 10)

Parks

- City Parks
 - Excellent/Good=38%
 - Fair/Poor=63%
- Recreation centers or facilities
 - Excellent/Good=24%
 - Fair/Poor=77%



Rate the Quality of City Services (Question #10)

Streets

- Street Repair
 - Excellent/Good=26%
 - Fair/Poor=75%



Rate the Quality of City Services (Question #10)

Code Compliance

- Code Enforcement (weeds, abandoned buildings, etc.)
 - Excellent/Good=21%
 - Fair/Poor=79%



Rate the Quality of Services (Question #12)

OVERALL

- City of Hanford
 - Excellent/Good=39%
 - Fair/Poor=62%
- Federal Government
 - Excellent/Good=26%
 - Fair/Poor=74%



How important should City's focus be on... (Question #13)

- Overall design or layout of residential/commercial areas (homes, buildings, streets, parks, etc.)
 - Essential/Very important=76%
 - Somewhat important/Not at all important=24%
- Overall feeling of safety
 - Essential/Very important=96%
 - Somewhat important/Not at all important=4%
- Overall quality of parks and recreation opportunities
 - Essential/Very important=78%
 - Somewhat important/Not at all important=22%
